According to Terri, "CKRH was the right place at the right time for me. It's a great place to serve, and it's exciting to think about what's in store for our organization in the future!"

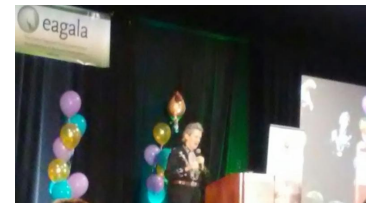
## Therapeutic Riding News
