The second week of camp is for our younger riders that requires some one-on-one Camp Counselors that can help make camp a memorable experience. Camp this summer will include; riding lessons, outside trail rides, horse educational activities, field trips down in the KHP, visitors with special demonstrations, crafts, games and much more fun - even some horse painting!

<u>Camp Commitment:</u> If possible, we ask that you please be available for all 4 days of camp, simply to help the week to run smoothly and for campers to bond with everyone. However, we understand that not everyone has this availability and we would love to have you for the days that you can committee to - so we are asking for a day long commitment. CKRH camp experience revolves around making memories and friendships that will last a lifetime!

Camp Horse Handlers - everything horses (Leading/Sidewalking for trail rides and/or group lessons, grooming, tacking, turning horses out, wrangling, barn help, etc). **Camp Counselors** - will be assigned a specific camper or assigned an activity (crafts, badge work, educational activities, etc).
