Celebrate the 25th Anniversary of the Paul Frazer Memorial Horse Show by volunteering!

Paul Frazer Memorial Horse Show will be held on Saturday, March 28, 2015! We need several volunteers to help with both the Dressage arena and the Jump stadium...

Dressage ring (7:30am – Noon): 4 volunteers needed to help run scores, help with check-in, be an assistant to the Dressage Stewards, keep the hospitality center organized, etc.)

Dressage ring (Noon – 4:00pm): 4 volunteers needed to help run scores, be an assistant to the Dressage Stewards, keep the hospitality center organized, help with event clean-up/take dressage rings down, etc.)

Jump Stadium (7:30am – 11:30): 2 volunteers needed to be **gate keeper** (open and close the gate for each participant) and **2 volunteers needed** for **jump crew** (put polls back up that have been knocked off between jumpers)

Jump Stadium (11:30am – 4:30pm): 2 volunteers needed to be **gate keeper** (open and close the gate for each participant) and **2 volunteers needed** for **jump crew** (put polls back up that have been knocked off between jumpers)

Event Clean-up (3:30pm – 7:00pm) 3-5 volunteer to help with taking down dressage rings at the end of the event, and then move to the jump stadium to help take down jump standards and put them on trailer, pack/clean up both hospitality centers and show office

Little Reminders:

- Be sure to come prepared for the weather! Layers, Layers, Layers.
- Please arrive at least 20 minutes prior to your schedule lesson time so that you can be sure that your horse is ready to go on time.
- Leaders – It is your responsibility to tack your horse and warm him/her up before the lesson
- Sidwalkers – you will pick up your rider(s) from the parent room and make sure their helmet is on correctly.
- Always check the field map before taking any horse out to their field for the night!
- Be sure to Sign **IN** and **OUT** each time you are here, and please keep up with your hours in Volgistics. Tracking volunteer hours is very important to us – for many reasons.
- Watch for school closings – if Fayette or Scott County are out, or sent home early, for weather then there are no services at CKRH. If inclement weather happens to be on a Saturday, check the following news sites for us to be listed as cancelled or closed.
